Please contact your RBC Account Manager to use these codes or your Pre-Authorized Debit payments will not be processed. Your payment will be identified as a "T" level error or "rejected" and reported on your Input Verification and Edit Report.

The 650 - Funds Transfer Pre-Authorized Transaction Code is restricted and can only be used for Debit transactions to consumer accounts.

CPA transaction code 650 can only be used by CPA Members (financial institutions, life insurance companies with assigned CPA numbers, etc.). The payor and the payee are the same individual and this code is only used for debit transactions to consumer accounts.



#### 420 Cash Management

The Cash Management Pre-Authorized Transaction Code can be used for Debits and Credits; however this CPA code is restricted for debits only. No Restriction on Credit Transactions.

CPA transaction code 420 is a PAD drawn on the account of a payor for the purpose of transferring, consolidation or repositioning funds between their account at one member of the Canadian Payments Association to their account at another member (e.g. transfers between a parent company and its subsidiary). This CPA code is only to be used for business-to-business transactions.
